Art. 1 Admission to Study Programmes in English

- a) Admission of applicants to study programmes taught in English for the academic year 2025/2026 shall be governed by these Conditions, Act. No. 111/1998 Coll, on Higher Education, as amended and the Statute of the Czech Technical University in Prague.
- b) The admission procedure is managed by the admission committee of each study programme appointed by the Dean.

Art. 2 Conditions of Admission

- a) Complete the application form by 31 March 2025 (see point 3).
- b) Pass the entrance examination (see point 4).
- c) Demonstrate proficiency in English. English proficiency will be assessed by the admission committee.
- d) Applicants for the Bachelor's degree programme must complete and submit a certificate of completion of secondary education before the enrolment deadline.
- e) Applicants for the Master's degree programme must complete and submit a certificate of completion of the Bachelor's degree before the enrolment deadline.

Art 3 How to Apply

To apply for degree programmes taught in English, the following three steps must be completed by 31 March 2025 at the latest:

- a) Complete and submit the online application form at <https://www.prihlaska.cvut.cz>.
- b) Pay the application processing fee (CZK 950) via the portal <https://prihlaska.cvut.cz/apps/kos/prihlaska/> or by bank transfer to the CTU FEL bank account. All bank fees are to be paid by the applicant.
- c) Deliver all documents required for admission:
 - Confirmation of study results.
 - Certificate of English language proficiency if the applicant is not a native speaker.
 - Motivation letter.

Applicants are also encouraged to submit documents demonstrating significant personal achievements or professional or academic excellence in electrical engineering, computer science, mathematics or physics.

All documents that are not in Czech, Slovak or English must be accompanied by a certified translation into Czech or English. A photocopy of the translation must be sent by post or e-mail, the original must be submitted before the enrolment deadline.

Art. 4 Admission Exam

The admissions exam consists of an online interview and an optional test, if the admissions committee decides on one. The scope, topics and timing of the admission interview (and the test, if required) will be sent to the applicant by e-mail after the application submission step has been completed.

Art. 5 Final Notes

- a) The information provided on <https://www.prihlaska.cvut.cz> and in the annexes to the application form must be accurate and complete. False or incomplete information may result in the application being rejected in the course of the admission procedure or possible later exclusion from studies if they are detected after enrolment in the study programme.
- b) By the end of October of the first semester of study, students must complete the process of nostrification of foreign secondary education for applicants applying to bachelor's degree programmes and university education for applicants applying to master's degree programmes at the CTU in Prague. This process requires more documents than are required in this admission procedure. Applicants are encouraged to obtain all necessary documents before arriving in the Czech Republic. The application for nostrification must be submitted before the start of the first semester of study.
- c) In the event of external objective circumstances, CTU FEE may change the conditions set out in these Conditions. In this case, CTU FEE will publish the change on the public website of the FEE and inform by e-mail all applicants who have already submitted an application.
